This unoaked Chardonnay is delightfully fresh and expressive, with vibrant aromas of citrus and tropical fruits.
- 15 McCorkindale Sauvignon Blanc,
Marlborough, New Zealand 2008 £21.00
This wine has a hint of gooseberry and cassis on the bouquet and a clean taste on the palate.
- 16 Trivento, Chardonnay Reserva
Mendoza, Argentina 2006 £17.00
This is a wine which is golden in colour, with complex aromas and rich flavours of tropical fruits.
- 17 Seaglass, Sauvignon Blanc
Napa Valley, California 2007 £21.00
A delicious wine that has elegant varietal aromas of fruit and floral overtones. It's palate is fresh and well balanced and the wine has a lovely smooth finish.
- 18 Miguel Torres, Viognier Organic
Curico Valley, Chile 2007 £21.00
Beautiful pale yellow colour. Intense aromas of fruit (grapefruit) and flowers (roses). In the mouth this wine is fresh. Silky and exhibits fine acidity. The finish is long and memorable.
- 19 Napa Cellars, Chardonnay
Napa Valley, California 2007 £27.00
The palate has huge fruit flavours reminiscent of tropical fruit, balanced by a layer of lemony acidity and a long. Polished finish. Its moderate acidity makes it a more versatile Chardonnay when pairing with food.
- 20 Allan Scott, Gewurztraminer
Marlborough, New Zealand 2007 £33.00
This is surrounded by floral complexities, especially rose petals, to add extra interest to the wine. The full palate is well balanced, elegant and structurally sound, due to the wild full solid ferment. It finishes well and long with a lingering spiciness.
- 21 Allan Scott, Sauvignon Blanc
Marlborough, New Zealand 2008 £27.00
A wine that has an exotic infusion of fresh ginger, sweet basil and lemon grass layered over ripe tropical and citrus fruits. Divine!
- 22 Wide River Chenin Blanc,
South Africa 2008 £15.00
A refreshing fruity wine that is off dry with a light flavour and just a hint of honey to its finish.

With its splendid, bright gold colour this wine develops complex aromas of hazelnut mixed with fine notes of honey.

Bekaa Valley, Lebanon 2004
The purple colour is deep and intense, with garnet-red reflection. The nose is clear and powerful with under-wood scents. This is a full bodied pulpy wine with aromas of sandalwood and incense. A most elegant wine with a long lingering finish.
- 69 Chateau Grand Corbin D'Espagne, £47.00
St Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux, France 1999
The wine is typically a blend of Merlot (75%), Cabernet Franc (20%) and Cabernet Sauvignon (5%). The grapes are fermented in a combination of temperature controlled stainless steel and concrete vats. The wines are then matured in oak barrels (40% new) for 12-15 month.
- 70 Pommard 1er Cru, Les Epenots £80.00
Burgundy, France 2002
Full bodied and glowing bright red in colour, this is a very refined Gevrey with sweet ripe fruit across the palate, and a fine long finish that has perfect poise.

Italy
A light semi-sparkling wine from Italy. This is a good companion for conversation between friends. It opens and closes a lunch: it is magnificent for any occasion.

NV, Italy
Fresh, dry and crammed with summer fruits, a sparkling version of the Italian grape Pinot Grigio, with a twist of pink. Enjoy chilled, perfect for all occasions.
- 102 Baron de Beaupre Brut, Charles £6.00 £33.00
Ellner, NV, Reims, France
Dry and fresh with a lasting mousse and the fresh bread flavours of typical champagne.
- 103 Pol Roger Brut Reserve 'White Foil' NV, Reims, France £55.00
This elegant champagne, which was once favoured by Sir Winston Churchill, is still family owned and operated. It's a rich Pinot Noir-dominated champagne with a fine mousse and thanks to extra bottle age has a lovely roundness, which our English palates seem to appreciate.

A light shade of pink, very delicate bouquet and a lovely concentration of ripe fruit on the palate.
- 106 Bollinger Special Cuvee £55.00
NV, Reims, France
A lovely champagne that is classically lean, with great depth and complexity, good intensity of ripe fruit. This is a wine that really shows its best after a couple of years of bottle age.
- 107 Dom Perignon Brut, £130.00
Reims, France 1999
Pale golden highlights with brioche, honey, almond and apricot.
- 108 Taittinger Comtes de Champagne Brut, £125.00
Reims, France 1999
Rich and luscious, with toasty notes, purity of fruit.

- 80 Nectar Botrytis Riesling 125ml £7.00 £20.00
Coonawarra, Australia 2006
The palate is rich and luscious, and displays honey, mandarin peel and apricot flavours finishing with a balancing, drying acidity.
- 81 Chateau La Chartreuse £25.00
Sauternes, France 2006
This is dense and supple, with a beautiful gold colour and a powerful bouquet of small crystallised fruit. On the palate, it is well-matured with notes of white flowers.
- 82 Tokaji Aszu 5 Puttonyos, Royal £30.00
Tokaji Company Blue label Hungary 2005 50cl
Very concentrated, with flavours of honey, apricots, spice and lime juice, but with much highre acidity that Sauternes or Muscat de Beaumes de Venise, so it's more refreshing. Serve well chilled. Perfect as an aperitif or with foie gras, rich liver pate or desserts.
